

# 125<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY CONFERENCE TRAMSHEDS FUNCTION CENTRE LAUNCESTON, TASMANIA FRIDAY, 15<sup>TH</sup> TO SUNDAY, 17<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2017

The 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Conference of MU Australia will be held at the Tramsheds Function Centre, 4 Invermay Road, Launceston from Friday afternoon, 15<sup>th</sup> to Sunday afternoon, 17<sup>th</sup> September 2017.

The Conference will begin with Registrations from 3.00 pm on Friday followed by the Official Opening of the Conference at dinner at the Tramsheds Function Centre.

The Opening Eucharist will be on Saturday morning. There will be two sessions during the day and some free time before the Formal Dinner with an after dinner speaker. On Sunday there will be two sessions plus some free time and the Conference will conclude with the Final Eucharist and official close of the Conference at 4.00 pm.

# The History

The first meeting of the Mothers' Union was held at Christ Church, Cullenswood in 1892. A small group of ladies met on the verandah of the Rectory under the enthusiastic leadership of Mrs L'Oste and founded Mothers' Union in Australia.

The church was built by the Legge family on their property "Cullenswood" and was completed in 1847. By 1851 the area was becoming well settled with some six to eight grants issued in the area around "Cullenswood". The need for a town to service these settlers, servants and tenant farmers was obvious and a village began to spring up around the church.

Today the Church is the only surviving part of the village and is on private land.
